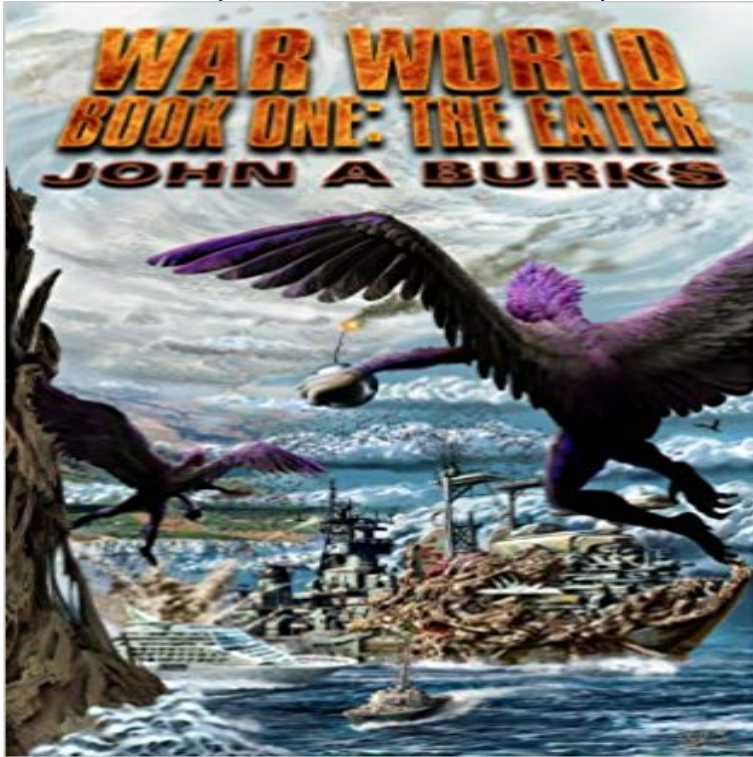


## The Eater (War World Book 1)
