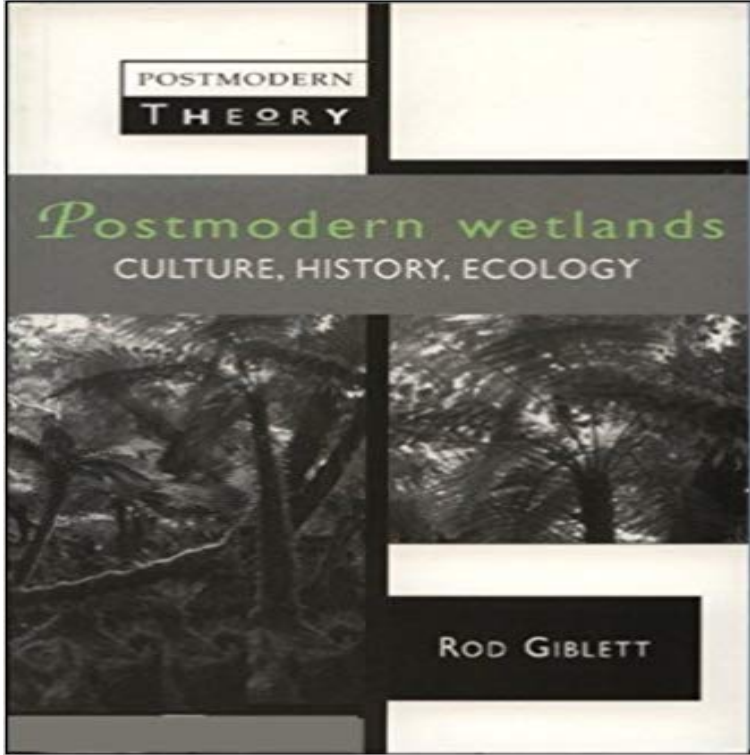


# Postmodern Wetlands: Culture, History, Ecology
