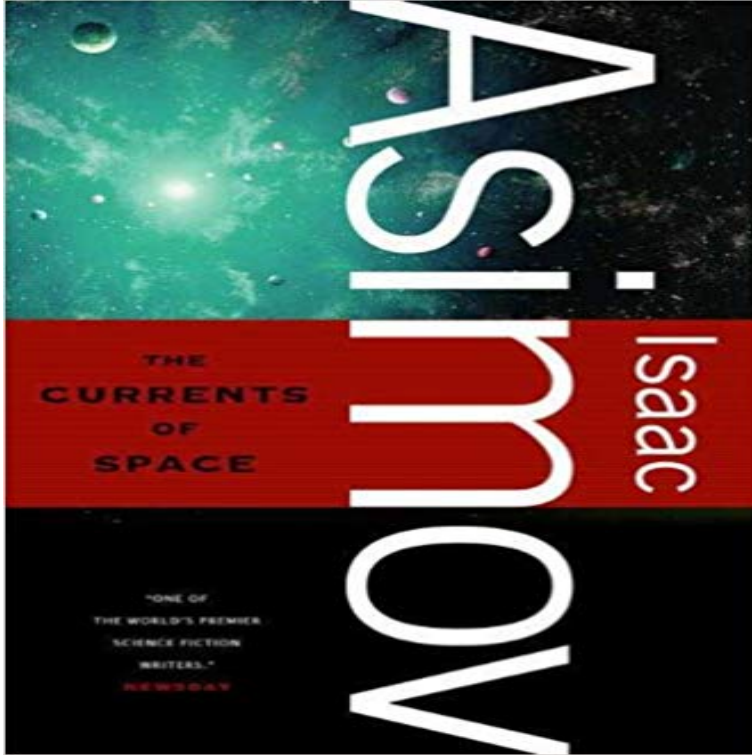


The Currents of Space (Galactic Empire series Book 2)
