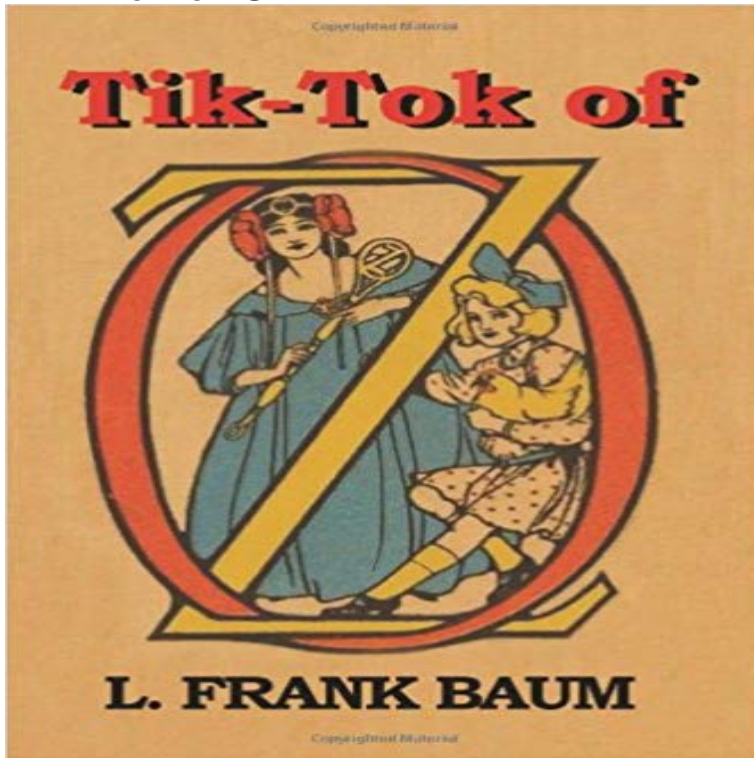


Tik-Tok of Oz
